



Drum Major Leadership Camp June 13-16, 2010

ARRIVAL AT UK CAMPUS

Registration for Kentucky Band Camp will be **4:00 pm - 5:30 pm Sunday, June 13**, at the Fine Arts Building located at the corner of Rose Street and Patterson Drive. A packet with camp badge, meal ticket, camp regulations, etc., will be given to you at this time. Parking for dormitory check-in will be available on a temporary basis.

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

Everyone should use his or her own judgment in planning what to bring to camp. Here are some of the necessities: appropriate (modest) clothing for instruction, shorts, t-shirts, athletic socks, tennis shoes, rain gear, sunscreen, sunglasses, hat or cap, water bottle, alarm clock (that works), casual clothing for evening social activities, swim wear, personal bath items such as extra towels, wash cloth, soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrush, mouthwash, lotion, band-aids, etc. If you are on medication, please bring a doctor's statement and make sure that you have your prescription available. **PLEASE DO NOT BRING SKATE BOARDS OR ROLLER SKATES.**

SPECIAL NEEDS FOR CAMP INCLUDE:

Drum Majors: Whistle, baton or mace (optional), music as desired, scores, tapes, recordings of your show music, notebook and pencils.

DORMITORIES AND MEALS

The students from all areas of the Kentucky Band Camp will be housed in the Haggin Hall housing complex. The rules are imposed on all residents, and there are absolutely no exceptions to this policy. Our staff will be present for the safety and convenience of all members of the camp. The dorms will provide two sheets, a blanket, pillow, and pillowcase. Each dorm room will have a telephone on which local calls can be made or incoming calls received.

Meals for dorm residents will be served at the Commons Cafeteria, in the Blanding/Kirwan complex, adjacent to Haggin Hall. The meal schedule serving times are as follows:

- Breakfast 8:30 - 9:15 am
- Lunch 12:00 - 1:30 pm
- Dinner 5:00 - 6:30 pm

A meal ticket will be issued for the entire week and should be treated as money. A meal ticket and camp badge will be necessary to get into the special cafeteria line set up for Kentucky Band Camp. **THERE WILL BE A \$10.00 SERVICE CHARGE FOR LOST MEAL CARDS. DO NOT LOSE YOUR MEAL CARD!**

PARKING

Those persons not staying in the dormitory who will need to drive a car to campus daily should park in the lots around Commonwealth Stadium. **Contact UK PARKING, 859-257-5757, to purchase a parking pass.** There is a bus service that runs from the stadium on a regular basis. Some early morning parking is available on the city streets surrounding the campus that can be used if so desired. There is to be **NO** use of cars during camp hours by either commuter or resident students. Resident campers who drive to campus should park after dorm check-in and leave their car for the remainder of camp. Appropriate parking for residents is in the Commonwealth Stadium lots or the Sports Center lots.

EXTRA MONEY

There is no required need for extra money. However, you may want to consider money for snacks, special Kentucky Band Camp T-shirts (\$10.00), UK souvenirs, camp supplies, etc.

MEDICAL FORMS/INSURANCE

The hospitals with which the Kentucky Band Camp is working in the event of sickness or accident has asked us to have treatment authorization forms for your protection. Thus, enclosed are important medical forms that **MUST BE COMPLETED, SIGNED, AND BROUGHT TO REGISTRATION. NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO REGISTER, STAY ON CAMPUS, OR PARTICIPATE IN THE CAMP WITHOUT THESE COMPLETED FORMS!!!**

In addition, a limited medical insurance policy is in effect for each student during his or her stay at the Kentucky Band Camp.

The schedule for the final day includes a final demonstration for all groups from 5:00 - 5:30 pm at Haggin Field, located next to Haggin Hall. Parents and friends are encouraged to attend this demonstration. In the event of inclement weather, the drum major demonstration will be cancelled.
