#### ARRIVAL AT UK CAMPUS

Registration for the James Campbell Drum Camp will be **9:00 am - 10:00 am EST Thursday, June 16, 2011** in the Lobby, on the ground floor, of the Fine Arts Building on the campus of the University of Kentucky. The Fine Arts Building is located on the corner of Patterson Drive and Rose Street. At this time you will receive your education materials and turn-in your medical form.

#### WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

Everyone should use his or her best judgment in planning what to bring to camp. Here are some of the necessities: appropriate (casual) clothing for instruction, sunscreen, sunglasses, hat or cap, and a water bottle. Students who are staying in the dormitory should also bring an alarm clock (that works), casual clothing for evening social activities, and personal bath items. If you are on medication, please bring a doctor's statement and make sure that you have your prescription available. **PLEASE DO NOT BRING SKATE BOARDS OR ROLLER SKATES.**

Percussionists should bring a practice pad (Real Feel model preferred), instrument, extra drum head, carrier, drum stand, and an extra pair of sticks or mallets. Although some of you will have graduated, try and borrow an instrument from your high school director. We plan to have some "pit" instruments available, however, **NO INSTRUMENTS WILL BE PROVIDED** unless you contact Mr. Campbell at (859) 257-8187.

#### MEALS

Meals and snacks are available at several local fast food restaurants. Students who have registered for the optional 4 Meals cafeteria plan will be served at the Commons Cafeteria, at the Kirwan/Blanding complex. A meal ticket and camp badge will be necessary to get into the special cafeteria line set up for the Kentucky Band Camp. **THERE WILL BE A \$10.00 SERVICE CHARGE FOR LOST MEAL CARDS.**

#### HOUSING

If you have elected to stay in a dormitory, you should know that students from all areas of the Kentucky Band Camp will be housed in the dorms on South Campus. The Kentucky Band Staff will act as counselors for the safety and convenience of all members of the camp. **The dorms will provide two sheets, a blanket, pillow, pillowcase, and three towels.**

#### PARKING

Parking for the camp will be in the conference lots behind Memorial Coliseum. Parking for dormitory check-in should be available on a temporary basis around the housing complex.

The hospital, with which the Kentucky Band Camp is working, in the event of sickness or accident, has asked us to have treatment authorization forms for your protection. Thus, enclosed is an important medical form, which **MUST BE COMPLETED, SIGNED, AND BROUGHT TO REGISTRATION. NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO REGISTER, STAY ON CAMPUS, OR PARTICIPATE IN THE CAMP WITHOUT THIS COMPLETED FORM!!!!**
